Out and about around Hailey

Occupation Lane

The ongoing issue of ownership and barriers that have been erected, was discussed at the July PC meeting. Our County Councillor, Liam Walker, has been asked to find out who owns the land. At the meeting, the PC agreed to the following proposal:

'HPC recognises that the status of, and access to, Occupation Lane is a matter of dispute, and would like to assist in the resolution of this matter. To that end, Hailey PC:

Welcomes the research undertaken to clarify the history of Occupation Lane in support of the Definitive Map Modification Order.

Asks our County Councillor, Liam Walker, to take up the issues of ownership, and the placing of gates and barriers at either end of Occupation Lane with OCC's Countryside Office, and other relevant departments.

Will seek clarification and information from the Land Registry with regard to the ownership, and status of Occupation Lane.

Invites adjacent landowners to provide any evidence they have of ownership of Occupation Lane.'
