Closure of main road (B4022) through Hailev this summer

As has been previously reported, SGN (who distribute our gas) will be undertaking mains gas work between 16 July and 7 September later this year. This work will require the closure of the main road (B4022) through Hailey for part/ all of this period.

Neighbourhood Plan

Following the consultation on the Strategic Environmental Assessment of the Neighbourhood Plan, the Parish Council has made some small changes and resolved to submit the plan to West Oxfordshire District Council (WODC). WODC will now submit the plan to an Inspector, which will be followed by a final consultation and then (probably in the autumn) a referendum of all registered voters in the parish prior to final adoption by WODC. The Parish web site https://haileywestoxon.org/neighbourhood-planning/ contains all of the relevant documentation associated with the ongoing process.

Land south west of Charlbury Rd, Hailey

The Sharba Homes planning application for 50 homes has gone straight to appeal as no decision had been made by WODC in the time frame allowed. Although it has no legal effect, WODC unanimously rejected the application at their June planning meeting. This notional decision will go forward to the appeal. Comments can be sent to the Inspector up to 11th July although all previous comments submitted will be forwarded to the Inspector.

The PC will consider the text of a further objection at the July meeting.
