Closure of main road (B4022) through Hailey this summer

As has been previously reported, SGN (who distribute our gas) will be undertaking mains gas work between 16 July and 7 September later this year. This work will require the closure of the main road (B4022) through Hailey for part/all of this period. Representatives from SGN and their contractor (GPL) attended the Annual Parish Meeting as well as Liam Walker (our County Councillor) to discuss the closure and the main areas of concern raised, which were as follows:

Impact of closure to residents – Access to properties should still be available by car and by foot during the closure. SGN have requested they should be made aware of any specific requirements during this time, such as large deliveries, disabled access requirements, etc. so that suitable arrangements can be made. The postman, milkman, carers, etc. will still be able to gain access. They confirmed that work will not be carried out during evenings or at weekends to help minimise disruption.

Impact of closure to businesses, school, etc. – SGN will put out "Businesses Open as Usual" signage and access will still be available. As the period overlaps school term time, road closure preparations will be started (road markings, exploratory works, etc.) with the closure in operation only once school holidays have started. Contractor vehicles will be parked within the area of works, not in the village lay-bys.

Communication – SGN will communicate with affected residents, businesses, school, etc. ahead of starting the works. If residents have any concerns (such as holidays planned during this time) they should call SGN to discuss (see details below).

Diversion route and damage to roads/verges — Oxfordshire County Council (OCC) will put in place diversion routes for vehicles wanting to drive beyond the village in either direction. Concerns over proposed routes (through Delly End, Poffley End, Priest Hill Lane, etc.) have been expressed and Liam is looking into these directly with OCC Highways Department. Ideas being explored include temporary speed limit reductions, appropriate HGV signage, and public transport access. SGN will be responsible for reinstatement in the event of any damage


