

Minutes of the **Online Extraordinary Meeting of the Parish Council on 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2020 at 2pm**

1. **Apologies for absence** were received from Cllrs Doland and Rogers
2. **To receive Declarations of Interest:** None were received.
3. **To note a Covid-19 risk assessment for the playground has been carried out**  
A Covid-19 specific risk assessment was carried out on Monday 29<sup>th</sup> July by Cllrs Gibson and McGibbon.
4. **To consider the re-opening of the playground from 4<sup>th</sup> July, following Government guidelines**  
Following the easing of restrictions by the Government, it was **resolved** to re-open the playground on Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> July.  
Leaflets have been distributed to all households in the parish, and displayed on the website, Facebook and noticeboards.  
Posters displaying the new rules will be displayed; including users to bring hygiene products with them.  
Signs stating how many users on a piece of equipment/benches will be displayed.  
Signs reminding users of social distancing will also be displayed  
These will be put up on Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> July.  
Weekly checks will be made of the playground to ensure it is being used appropriately and that signage is still legible. This will be reviewed at the August PC meeting.
5. **To consider expenditure necessary for the re-opening of the playground.**  
An Emergency authorisation of £123.30 was made by the Chairman to purchase posters and signs as these will need to be displayed on a medium to long-term basis.  
This was **resolved**.
