This is the latest Covid-19 leaflet from Hailey Parish Council to provide information and support to village residents who need it.

You will be aware that England is now in a full lockdown. Please see the reverse of this leaflet for a summary of the new lockdown rules and where to get reliable information.

Although many people now have well-established support systems for getting shopping, prescription collections, dog walking, or a regular phone contact, the Parish Council is concerned that this may not apply to everyone. Also, it is likely that as it is estimated that 1 in 50 people currently have the virus, whether they know this or not, more people will become ill. So, this time around, as well as those people who have been asked by the Government to shield because of their age or health, it is likely that others may have to self-isolate because they or a member of their household is ill.

The Parish Council is reviving the Hailey Help Hub to ensure that everyone who needs help can get it. And we have already had lots of offers from our fantastic volunteers – so a huge THANK YOU to all of you who have offered help so far.

As in the last lockdown ...

Please contact your area Parish Councillor (details below) if:

- 1. You or your household are self-isolating and need help** – collecting shopping or prescriptions, dog walking, or would like regular phone contact, or
- 2. You are well and willing to volunteer** to help with the above, or
- 3. You know or hear of anyone who needs help**

REALLY IMPORTANT – IF YOU ARE SHIELDING OR SELF-ISOLATING. We'd like to avoid the use of cash – for health and security reasons – so if you are able to organise click-and-collect shopping on-line, we can arrange collection and delivery to you if you are unable to get a delivery slot from the store. IF YOU DO NOT HAVE A COMPUTER. Some stores provide a telephone-and-collect service. You will need to contact the store to register, order your shopping and pay with your bank or credit card over the phone. Telephone Ann Gibson on 700162 or send a text to 07771 711187. She will arrange the collection with one of our wonderful volunteers.

LOOKING OUT FOR EACH OTHER: Mental health will continue to be a growing priority during the winter, and we encourage everyone to regularly pick up the phone, text, email, etc. to anyone who might benefit from the extra contact.

New lockdown rules for England



Stay home - only leave for work, essential shopping, exercise or medical appointments



Exercise allowed outdoors once a day, in your local area. You can exercise with your household, support bubble, or one other person



Schools closed except for vulnerable pupils and children of critical workers. Universities teaching online, with some course exceptions



No household mixing indoors or outdoors unless in your support or childcare bubble



Non-essential shops, leisure and entertainment venues closed



Pubs and restaurants closed, but takeaway food permitted
