
Project Hailey Jubilee Lottery

Follow the **Jubilee Procession** round the village on **Saturday afternoon 4**th **June** and end up at the village hall for **a superb Cream Tea**, offered by the Village Hall Management Committee as their contribution to the celebrations.

It seems to have taken forever but finally, we have a **superfast broadband connection** in the Village Hall, thanks to Gigaclear who have given installation and the first-year rental free of charge as part of their Community Support. As well as offering more facilities to our current hirers, we would also like to hear suggestions of how we can help the local community, many of whom we know do not yet benefit from a superfast connection. The Village Hall Annual General Meeting was held in the hall on 12th May. The committee reported on the hall's activities during the previous year (April 21 – March 22) including major expenses such as renewal of the flat roof, purchase of a new all-electric oven, refurbishment of the committee room and the main entrance doors. After the removal of COVID restrictions, lettings showed a 15% increase on the previous year but fell away in March 22. The annual accounts were approved and all Trustees re-elected. No new Trustees were appointed.

Hailey F.C. Martin Friend

Hailey has now concluded their successful season winning another two trophies from the three finals contested in the Oxfordshire Charity Cup final held at Oxford City F.C.

Hailey came up against a strong Yarnton team boosted by players form Tackley's Sunday League winning side. Hailey lost the game 7-2 having two players sent off, one of which, evidence proved that the referee's decision was wrong and that the Yarnton goalkeeper should have been dismissed instead for violent play. The video evidence came courtesy of the Oxfordshire F.A. without Hailey having to appeal the original referee's decision, enabling our player to be available for the Oxfordshire Junior Shield the following week, also at Oxford City against Bicester. In the Yarnton game the two players sent off contributed little to the result as Yarnton were leading 5-2 at the time.

For the final against Bicester, the result was a repeat of the Yarnton score but in reverse. Hailey winning comfortably in the end. On the Tuesday following, Hailey played Stonesfield in the Witney and District Senior Challenge Cup, narrowly beating Stonesfield I-0.

In the final game of the league season, Hailey drew 3-3 with Charlbury Town, after which Hailey was presented with the Premier League Trophy.
