

Hailey Parish Defibrillators

We had a very successful morning on Saturday 25th March when Dick Tracey (Paramedic Trainer) kindly did a presentation and demonstration on the workings of Defibrillators at the Village Hall. This was funded by the Parish Council and very well attended. Thank you Dick, yet again, for a most interesting and informative morning.

Defibrillator Locations Update:

The Defibrillator that was previously at the rear of The Lamb & Flag has now been moved to the front of the **Village Hall** - next to the Main Entrance. Grateful thanks to the Parish Council for paying for this re-location. My thanks also go to Matt Cantwell at the Lamb & Flag for supplying the electricity which has kept the Cabinet and the Defibrillator 'warm' for so many years. The Defib at **Hailey Primary School** is available for use by the general public and is located on the outside wall of the Main School Building (adjacent to the carpark). The New Yatt defibrillator is next to the Parish Notice Board in **New Yatt Lane**, outside Chapel Cottage. Thanks go to Giles Doland and Martin Crow of New Yatt for getting the power supply and Cabinet installed. All three locations have been registered with the Ambulance Service and The British Heart Foundation's 'The Circuit'. All are available 24 hours a day. Note: **Witney Rugby Club** also have a Defibrillator located on the outside wall of their Club House (overlooking the playing fields).

Churchyard News: 'Count on Nature' event Sat 3rd June 10am - 12 noon

It's lovely to see so many people visiting and walking through the churchyard and burial ground, enjoying the exuberant growth of May and all the wildflowers and grasses to be found there.

Churchyards are important places of peace and solace for people. They are also refuges for wildlife which use them as stepping stones to move around. The 20,000 or so churchyards of England and Wales together make up an area the size of a small national park like Exmoor, so in looking after our churchyard here in Hailey, we are part of something much, much bigger.

St John's is a member of Caring for God's Acre, a charity which supports churches in looking after their churchyards for both people and wildlife. Its president is King Charles. We are following their management plan for this special place in our community.

We have a new grass cutter in 2023 who will be keeping the grass shorter around the graves on a regular basis. The grass will be allowed to grow longer in the older parts of the churchyard, then the whole area will be cut in late summer. This will give the flowers the chance to seed and the whole area will provide food and shelter for insects, birds and other animals.

Caring for God's Acre is holding a 'Love your Burial Ground: Count on Nature' week of activities in early June. This will be run jointly with the Church of England and others. It will focus on celebrating and recording the brilliant wildlife to be found in churchyards around the country. You can find out more at: caringforgodsacre.org.uk

In Hailey, we will be holding an event on Saturday 3rd June from 10am – 12noon. Come along and see what you can spot in the way of plants, birds, insects and animals. We will record this information and submit it to National Biodiversity Network using an app called iNaturalist. If you want, you can download the iNaturalist app beforehand – it's brilliant!

We will also be doing some summer tidying, so do bring gloves, shears, a rake. You will be most welcome and there will be cake and refreshments.

Hailey FC Martin Friend

The end of the season has arrived, half way through May, normally the season has finished by the last Saturday in April but the weather has played a part in the season's extension. Another has been that the League seems to have decided that the Senior Challenge Cup and the Junior Challenge Cup have been played as night games. In these competitions, Hailey's first team played Stonesfield in a repeat of last year's final, but relinquished their title in the first round to Stonesfield losing 2-1.

The reserve team reached the semi-final, having got past Ducklington and Cassington. In the semi-final Hailey Reserves had home advantage over their opponents Chadlington Sports but lost in a high scoring game 4-3 to exit the Junior Challenge Cup. Carrying on with the exploits of the reserve team, in the final at the Jack Busby Memorial Cup held at Clanfield, Hailey Reserves gained a narrow win against Chadlington Sports Reserves winning 2-1 to retain their title. League wise the reserves retain their place in Division One for another season.

The first team did not manage to make history by retaining the Oxfordshire Junior Shield, losing to Cravenhill 4-2 despite taking the lead within the first three minutes, only to concede three goals in the next twenty minutes.

The Premier Division title is the only competition Hailey have retained, decided on the last game of the season which depended on Stonesfield beating Freeland by thirteen goals, but only managed to score six, so Hailey retained the title on goal difference. Hailey helped their cause by beating Stonesfield in Hailey's last game of the season, winning 2 – 0. On the previous Saturday, Hailey beat Spartan Rangers on a waterlogged pitch on the Hailey playing field. Plenty of aqua-plaining, it was that bad, the referee could have easily abandoned the game before it started. Because of the rain, our reserve team game against Witney Royal that was to follow was abandoned. The referee for this game didn't turn up either.

The third team pulled out of the league with six weeks of the season to go.




