## NORTH WITNEY HOUSING DEVELOPMENT

This proposal to build 1,400 dwellings in Hailey parish – between Hailey Road and Woodstock Road, on the edge of Witney – has become active. The consortium has published an Environmental Impact Assessment Scoping Report and associated documentation. This development was originally scheduled to begin construction in 2021/22 but is running at least 3 years late. Full details are available on the WODC online-applications web site– reference 23/01512/SCOPE. There is likely to be a formal consultation in the coming months.

The area will be mown back to its usual height in time for the upcoming peace memorial service in early July.

## **JMB SOLAR FARM – BETWEEN POFFLEY AND NEW YATT**

The planning application reports for the 35MW proposed Solar Farm are expected to be published on WODC's web site at the end of June. There will be more survey work over the summer. The inclusion of the originally proposed field east of New Yatt Road has been withdrawn and replaced by an area to the south of the site. The proposal will include inclusion of the privately owned paths through the area as an amenity open to the public. Existing rights of way will not change. The community area will include an orchard.

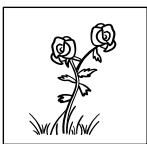
